BIL10	Biblical Leadership	This course covers the subject of Biblical Leadership from the standpoint of walking in obedience and the consequences of disobedience.	2
BIP10	Biblical Prosperity	Prosperity from an overall view point - spiritual, physical, material and etc.	2
CHE10	Christian Ethics	Explains what biblical ethics are and the importance of ethics in ministry.	1
DIH10	Divine Healing	Study of biblical teaching on divine healing and divine health.	2
EVA10	Evangelism	A study of outreach ministry with an emphasis on God's redemptive plan and the responsibility of each Christian in the ministry of reconciliation.	1
EVA11	Evangelism Internship	Hands on application of the principles studied in the Evangelism class. Students intern at various sites.	2
EIF11	Ever Increasing Faith	Explains what faith is and its place in the life of the Believer. The principles explained are for application in both life and ministry.	2
HDF30	How to Defend Your Faith (Apologetics)	Apologetics is the defense of Christianity. Its purpose is to show that the non-Christian will not be acting irrationally by trusting in Christ or by accepting the Bible as God's word.	2
HPE10	How to Pray Effectively	Basic tenants of prayer and its effectiveness.	2
HSB10	How to Study the Bible	Basic methods of bible study, with assignments on using three of the methods for independent bible study.	3
MIH10	Ministry of Helps	History, definition, purpose, and organization of the ministry of helps in the local church.	1
MIL00	Ministry Lab	Similar to Chapel, this period of time will allow for: topics pertinent to all students, guest speakers, Church Behind the Scenes and praise and worship. Students will receive a Pass or No Pass credit for attendance and participation.	1
MOG30	Motivational Gifts	Based upon the motivational gifts described in Romans chapter 12: How to identify your motivational gift and how to serve effectively with the other motivational gifts God has placed in the church.	2
NTS10	New Testament Survey	A general view of the 27 books of the New Testament for the purpose of acquainting the student with the background, theme, major divisions and messages of each book.	3
OTS10	Old Testament Survey	A survey of the 39 books of the old testament in the light of their historical background, structure, content, and distinctive qualities.	3
PHF10	Principles of Faith/How to Obtain Strong Faith: 6 Principles	First in a three part series on the dynamic principles of faith. This session will focus on the six principles that govern strong faith.	2
PHF11	Principles of Faith/Faith's Greatest Enemies	Second in a three part series on the dynamic principles of faith. This session will focus on the enemies of faith.	2
PHF20	Principles of Faith/How to Develop Your Faith	Third in a three part series. This session helps you identify your faith level and explores the keys to developing your faith.	2
REP10	Redeemed from Poverty, Sickness & Death	A course of study on some of the benefits made available to believers through the redemptive work of Christ.	2
RIG10	Righteousness	A detailed study of the doctrine of justification as found in Romans chapters 1-5.	1
SAN10	Sanctification	A detailed study of the teaching on sanctification as found in Romans chapters 6-8.	1
SPG20	Spiritual Gifts	A study of the spiritual gifts with biblical and contemporary examples. Students will learn to identify all nine gifts and learn how to operate in the gifts of the Spirit.	2
HOS10	The Holy Spirit	The Holy Spirit's role in the life of the Christian, including the work, ministry, and gifts of the Holy	2

CHM30	Children's Ministry	How to teach God's word to children through practical use of the seven laws of the teacher.	2
CHH31	Church History I	First in a two part series looking at the inward and outward development of the church.	2
CHH32	Church History II	Second in a two part series looking at the inward and outward development of the church.	2
COM20	Church & Organizational Management	The process of planning and implementing administration in the local church and Christian organizations, using both biblical and organizational principles.	3
CPF20	Church Planting/Field Ministry	Techniques of starting new churches, using biblical and sociological principles.	3
GOC20	God's Covenants	The background of covenant in history. Special emphasis on biblical covenants, leading to the new covenant between Christ and the Church.	3
GOS20	Gospels	The study of the life, mission and teachings of the Lord Jesus Christ.	3
HHV30	Home & Hospital Visitation	Overview of qualifications and training for ministering through visitation at home, hospitals, jails, and bereavement situations.	2
INT20	Internship	Simulated group projects related to ministry situations, using information gained from the AFPMTI curriculum.	3
INC20	Introduction to Counseling I	Covers overview of State legal/ethical mandates and an introduction to areas basic to counseling from a biblical perspective. The focus will be on counselor traits, goals, skills and how to apply biblical approaches/principles to deal with the issue of depression.	3
INC21	Introduction to Counseling II	The second part of Introduction to counseling, with an emphasis on changes one can expect through Christian Counseling.	3
MIA20	Ministerial Administration	Workshops and lectures on techniques and procedures for operating in ministry administrative positions.	3
MNC20	Ministerial Communications	A course on basic English grammar and effective writing techniques.	3
PAM20	Pastoral Ministry	Biblical foundations of pastoral ministry, dealing specifically with the pastor's role in ministry. Also includes the calling, character, and commitment of a person called to one or more of the fivefold ministry offices.	3
PRW30	Praise & Worship	The biblical basis for praise and worship in the Church today.	2
SEP20	Sermon Preparation	The expository method of preaching, with various types of sermons.	3
SRP20	Sermon Presentation	The practice, presentation and critique of sermons. Students will minister on given portions of scripture with application.	3
SPW20	Spiritual Warfare	An advanced course on prayer. Emphasis on identifying the enemy, spiritual armor, and pulling down strongholds in the context of evangelism, church planting, and everyday life.	3
STH20	Study of Hebrew I	This course teaches the basics of Biblical Hebrew vocabulary and grammar. Students will learn how to speak the vocabulary and basic Hebrew words.	3
STH21	Study of Hebrew II	This course is a continuation of the first course with an emphasis on developing the ability to read and translate basic text of the Bible in its original languages.	3
TAN30	Table of Nations (Genealogy of Mankind)	Explores the genealogy of mankind.	3
TEM30	Teen Ministry	How to teach God's word to Teens through practical use of the seven laws of the teacher.	2
EPI30	The Epistles	A study of the letters of Apostle Paul and their effect on the development of the church.	2
WOR30	World Religions	A comparative study of major world religions.	3
